CONDITIONAL SENTENCES (1)

### Zero conditional sentences

### If clause (condition): simple present Main clause (result): simple present

If water reaches a hundred degrees, it boils.

If people eat too much, they get fat.

If you touch a fire, you get burned.

People die if they don't eat.

If I get a headache, I take a pain killer.

### **Notice**

Incorrect: When people smoke cigarette, their health will suffer.

Correct: When people smoke cigarette, their health suffer.

# First conditional sentences

If clause (condition): simple present Main clause (result): simple future

If you can leave work earlier, shall we meet up?

If she doesn't hurry, she'll be late.

If you lend him money, he may not give it back to you.

If you arrive late to work, will you be fired?

If I'm late tonight, my mom will be angry.

## **Examples of zero and first conditional sentences:**

If people exercise, they feel better.

When people get angry, they don't think correctly.

If you push this button, the volume increases.

Dogs bark when they are hungry.

If you have free time, what do you like to do?

What do you do if you find money in the street?

If it rains, I won't go to the park.

If I study today, I will go to the party tonight.

If I have enough money, I will buy some new shoes.

She will be late if the train is delayed.

If she doesn't leave soon, she will miss the bus.

If I see her, I'll tell her.
